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001 affectionate *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

showing fondness or tenderness

The **affectionate** puppy greeted everyone with enthusiastic tail wags, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: Affection feels like a warm arm around someone; affectionate behavior shows fondness and tenderness.

002 alarmed *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

feeling frightened or worried about potential danger

Residents were **alarmed** by the sudden increase in crime rates, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An alarm makes your heart jump; alarmed means frightened or worried by possible danger.

003 amusing *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

causing laughter or providing entertainment

The comedian told an **amusing** story about his childhood, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: An amusing act puts laughter in the audience and turns boredom into entertainment.

004 animosities *noun***EMOTION & FEELING**

strong feelings of hostility or hatred

Old **animosities** between the rival families finally came to an end, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: ANIMOSITY sounds like ENEMY: animosities are strong hostile feelings held between enemies.

005 collected *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

gathered together; calm and composed

Despite the chaos, she remained calm and **collected**, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: Collected items gather in one basket; a collected person gathers their emotions and stays calm.

006 comforting *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

providing solace or reassurance

Her **comforting** words helped ease his anxiety, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A warm blanket around a worried child is comforting because it offers solace and reassurance.

007 **concern** *noun*

EMOTION & FEELING

a matter of interest or importance; worry

Safety is our primary **concern** during the renovation, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A concern sits under a spotlight because it matters, while a worry cloud hangs above it.

008 **concerning** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

causing worry; relating to

The doctor found some **concerning** symptoms during the examination, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A concerning sign flashes a warning light; concerning can also mean relating to that subject.

009 **concerns** *noun*

EMOTION & FEELING

matters of interest or worry

She raised several **concerns** about the proposed budget cuts, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: Concerns are important matters stored in a folder beneath a small cloud of worry.

010 **disagreeable** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

unpleasant or unenjoyable; bad-tempered

The **disagreeable** weather forced us to cancel the outdoor picnic, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A sour taste and a scowling face both signal something disagreeable or unpleasant.

011 **disconcerting** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

causing one to feel unsettled or disturbed

The sudden silence in the room was **disconcerting** to everyone present, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A disconcerting event makes the floor seem to tilt, leaving a person unsettled.

012 **distressed** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

suffering from anxiety, sorrow, or pain; in a state of difficulty

The **distressed** animal was rescued by wildlife volunteers, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A distressed person stands beneath a storm cloud of anxiety, sorrow, pain, or hardship.

013 drawn *verb/adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

pulled or attracted; depicted with lines; looking strained or tired

She was **drawn** to the mysterious painting hanging in the gallery, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A magnet pulls, a pencil sketches, and a tired face tightens: three images for drawn.

014 enthusiasm *noun***EMOTION & FEELING**

intense and eager enjoyment, interest, or approval

Her **enthusiasm** for the project was contagious and motivated the entire team, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: Enthusiasm is a bright inner engine of eager interest and enjoyment.

015 excited *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

very enthusiastic and eager; emotionally aroused

The children were **excited** about their upcoming trip to the amusement park, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An excited person is a shaken bottle of eager energy ready to burst.

016 incensed *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

extremely angry; enraged

The customers were **incensed** by the company's poor service, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An incensed person burns red with rage as steam blasts from both ears.

017 indifference *noun***EMOTION & FEELING**

lack of interest, concern, or sympathy

His **indifference** to her feelings caused their relationship to deteriorate, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: Indifference sleeps through both a celebration and a plea for concern.

018 interest *noun***EMOTION & FEELING**

a feeling of curiosity about something; a quality that attracts attention

She developed an **interest** in astronomy after visiting the planetarium, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: Interest is a curiosity magnet that pulls attention toward a subject.

019 **intriguing** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

arousing curiosity or interest; fascinating

The detective found an **intriguing** clue at the scene, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An intriguing locked box pulls curiosity toward its unanswered question.

020 **inviting** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

offering the promise of pleasure or satisfaction; attractive and tempting

The cozy fireplace and soft chairs made the room very **inviting**, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An inviting doorway glows warmly and promises pleasure inside.

021 **jarring** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

causing a physical shock or jolt; incongruous in a striking way

The **jarring** noise of the alarm startled everyone awake, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A jarring clash is a sudden jolt, like one neon tile in a calm pattern.

022 **liked** *verb*

EMOTION & FEELING

found agreeable or enjoyable; had affection for

Everyone **liked** the new employee because of her friendly attitude, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A bright heart beside the object shows it was found agreeable and liked.

023 **lonely** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

sad because of having no friends or company; isolated

Living alone in the countryside made her feel **lonely** at times, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: One empty chair beside a solitary person captures the sadness of being lonely.

024 **nervous** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

easily agitated or anxious; relating to the nerves

She felt **nervous** before her first job interview, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A nervous figure trembles while alarm signals race along visible nerves.

025 **offended** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

resentful or annoyed due to a perceived insult

He felt **offended** by the remark about his work ethic, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An insult arrow striking a respect shield leaves the person offended and resentful.

026 **overreacts** *verb*

EMOTION & FEELING

responds more emotionally or forcibly than is justified

He often **overreacts** to minor inconveniences, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A tiny spark causing a giant alarm shows someone overreacts beyond what is justified.

027 **overwhelmed** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

overcome completely in mind or feeling; buried beneath a huge mass

She felt **overwhelmed** by the amount of work she had to complete, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A person buried beneath a mountain of tasks and feelings is overwhelmed.

028 **regret** *noun/verb*

EMOTION & FEELING

to feel sad, repentant, or disappointed over something that has happened or been done

I **regret** not spending more time with my grandparents, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: Regret looks backward at a past action beneath a cloud of sadness and disappointment.

029 **regrettable** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

deserving regret; unfortunate; undesirable

It was a **regrettable** decision that led to many problems, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A regrettable event leaves a backward-looking trail of sadness and an UNFORTUNATE stamp.

030 **regretted** *verb*

EMOTION & FEELING

felt sad or disappointed about something that happened or was done

He **regretted** his harsh words as soon as he said them, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: The past action was regretted when it returned to mind with sadness and disappointment.

031 rousing *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

exciting; stirring; capable of arousing strong emotions

The coach gave a **rousing** speech before the championship game, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A rousing speech strikes a drumbeat that stirs strong emotion and excitement.

032 sanguine *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

optimistic or positive, especially in a difficult situation

Despite the setbacks, she remained **sanguine** about the project's success, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A sanguine person holds a bright sun above a storm and expects a good outcome.

033 satisfying *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

giving fulfillment or pleasure; meeting expectations

Completing the marathon was an incredibly **satisfying** achievement, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A satisfying result fills both the needs gauge and the pleasure gauge.

034 sensitive *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

quick to detect or respond to slight changes; easily offended or upset

This is a **sensitive** topic that requires careful discussion, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A sensitive detector reacts to one feather; a sensitive person reacts strongly to slight hurts.

035 startle *verb***EMOTION & FEELING**

to cause someone to feel sudden shock or alarm

The loud noise made her **startle** and drop her coffee, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A sudden air horn makes the whole body jump; it startles.

036 surprise *noun/verb***EMOTION & FEELING**

an unexpected event; to cause someone to feel astonishment

The party was a complete **surprise** to the birthday girl, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A box opening to an unexpected sight creates surprise.

037 **surprising** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

causing astonishment or wonder; unexpected

It was **surprising** to learn that he had never traveled abroad, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A surprising event jumps from an unopened box before anyone expects it.

040 **unbothered** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

not troubled or concerned; undisturbed

She remained **unbothered** by the criticism and continued with her work, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: An unbothered person calmly reads while alarms flash nearby.

038 **tedious** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

long, slow, and tiresome; boring due to length or monotony

The **tedious** task of filing paperwork took the entire afternoon, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A tedious task repeats the same slow step along an extremely long road.

041 **unsympathetic** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

not feeling or showing sympathy; indifferent or hostile

The **unsympathetic** manager refused to grant any extensions on the deadline, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An unsympathetic face turns away from another person's tears.

039 **tranquil** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

free from disturbance; calm and peaceful

The **tranquil** lake reflected the surrounding mountains like a mirror, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A tranquil lake has an unbroken surface beneath a quiet sky.

042 **worried** *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

feeling or showing anxiety or unease about actual or potential problems

The **worried** parents waited anxiously for news of their missing child, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A worried mind circles a possible problem beneath an anxiety cloud.

043 apathetic *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

showing or feeling no interest or enthusiasm

The **apathetic** voters stayed home on election day, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: An apathetic person sleeps while an exciting parade passes by.

046 elated *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

ecstatically happy

She was **elated** by the news of her promotion, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An elated person floats upward beneath balloons of ecstatic happiness.

044 stoic *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

enduring pain without showing feelings

She remained **stoic** throughout the ordeal, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A stoic face stays calm and unreadable while enduring pain.

047 despondent *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

in low spirits from loss of hope

He became **despondent** after losing his job, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A despondent figure sinks beneath a broken hope balloon.

045 volatile *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

liable to change rapidly and unpredictably

His **volatile** temper made negotiations difficult, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A volatile gauge swings suddenly and unpredictably from calm to explosive.

048 jubilant *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

feeling or expressing great happiness

The **jubilant** fans celebrated the victory, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A jubilant crowd leaps beneath confetti in great happiness.

049 melancholy *noun***EMOTION & FEELING**

a deep sadness or gloom

A sense of **melancholy** pervaded the empty house, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: Melancholy is a deep blue cloud of quiet, lingering sadness.

050 euphoric *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

characterized by intense excitement and happiness

The **euphoric** crowd cheered wildly, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A euphoric person rises on a surge of intense excitement and happiness.

051 somber *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

dark or dull; gloomy

The **somber** mood reflected the tragic news, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A somber room is dark, quiet, and covered by a gloomy gray tone.

052 ecstatic *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

feeling overwhelming happiness

She was **ecstatic** when she won the award, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: An ecstatic figure bursts upward with overwhelming happiness.

053 morose *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

sullen and ill-tempered

His **morose** demeanor worried his friends, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A morose person sits beneath a dark cloud with a sullen frown.

054 serene *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

calm, peaceful, and untroubled

The **serene** lake reflected the mountains, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A serene lake lies perfectly calm beneath an untroubled sky.

055 agitated *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

feeling or appearing troubled or nervous

The **agitated** passenger demanded to see a manager, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An agitated mind shakes like a jar filled with nervous thoughts.

058 content *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

in a state of peaceful happiness

She felt **content** with her simple life, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A content person rests peacefully beside a full needs gauge.

056 placid *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

calm and peaceful; tranquil

The **placid** surface of the pond was undisturbed, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A placid pond remains calm and peaceful without a ripple.

059 disgruntled *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

angry or dissatisfied

The **disgruntled** employees filed a complaint, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A disgruntled worker wears an angry frown beside an empty satisfaction gauge.

057 turbulent *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

characterized by conflict or disorder

The country experienced **turbulent** political times, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: Turbulent water churns chaotically like a scene of conflict and disorder.

060 exuberant *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

filled with lively energy and excitement

Her **exuberant** personality brightened the room, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: Exuberant energy bursts outward like bright confetti from a lively person.

061 subdued *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

quiet and rather reflective or depressed

The audience was **subdued** after the sad performance, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A subdued room lowers its volume and color into quiet reflection.

062 buoyant *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

cheerful and optimistic

Despite setbacks, she remained **buoyant**, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A buoyant mood floats above difficulty with cheerful optimism.

063 dejected *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

sad and depressed

The **dejected** team left the field in silence, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A dejected figure slumps beneath a downward arrow of sadness.

064 animated *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

full of life or excitement; lively

The **animated** discussion lasted for hours, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An animated speaker seems powered by lively motion and excitement.

065 fervent *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

having passionate intensity

She made a **fervent** plea for justice, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A fervent belief burns with a steady flame of passionate intensity.

066 indifferent *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

having no particular interest or concern

He seemed **indifferent** to the outcome, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: An indifferent person shows no movement on the interest or concern gauge.

067 passionate *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

showing strong feelings or beliefs

She gave a **passionate** speech about equality, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A passionate belief glows with a strong inner fire.

070 vivacious *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

attractively lively and animated

Her **vivacious** personality charmed everyone, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A vivacious person lights the room with attractive, animated energy.

068 dispassionate *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

not influenced by strong emotion; rational

The judge remained **dispassionate** throughout the trial, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A dispassionate judge moves emotion aside and weighs facts rationally.

071 ebullient *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

cheerful and full of energy

Her **ebullient** personality lifted everyone's spirits, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: Ebullient joy bubbles over with cheerful energy.

069 nostalgic *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

feeling longing for the past

The old photographs made her feel **nostalgic**, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A nostalgic person reaches toward a glowing photograph from the past.

072 sullen *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

bad-tempered and sulky

The **sullen** teenager refused to participate, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A sullen person sits apart with a dark, bad-tempered frown.

073 effervescent *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

vivacious and enthusiastic

Her **effervescent** charm delighted everyone, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: An effervescent personality bubbles with lively enthusiasm.

074 doleful *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

expressing sorrow; mournful

The **doleful** music matched the somber mood, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A doleful face hangs beneath a slow rain of sorrow.

075 jocular *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

fond of or characterized by joking

His **jocular** manner put people at ease, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A jocular person keeps a joke card ready for every conversation.

076 lugubrious *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

looking or sounding sad and dismal

The **lugubrious** expression never left his face, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A lugubrious voice drags slowly beneath a dark, dismal sadness.

077 jovial *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

cheerful and friendly

The **jovial** host welcomed every guest personally, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A jovial host combines cheerful laughter with friendly welcome.

078 melancholic *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

affected with or inclined to sadness

The **melancholic** poem moved readers to tears, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A melancholic mood rests beneath a lingering blue cloud of sadness.

079 pessimistic *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

tending to see the worst aspect of things

His **pessimistic** outlook proved unfounded, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A pessimistic forecast points toward the worst possible outcome.

080 mirthful *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

full of mirth; merry

Their **mirthful** laughter filled the room, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A mirthful crowd is full of merry laughter.

081 woeful *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

characterized by or expressing sorrow

The **woeful** tale brought tears to their eyes, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A woeful expression carries a heavy tear of sorrow.

082 exultant *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

triumphantly happy

The **exultant** winners celebrated loudly, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: An exultant winner leaps above the trophy in triumphant happiness.

083 forlorn *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

pitifully sad and lonely

The **forlorn** puppy waited at the shelter, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A forlorn figure sits alone on an empty platform, pitifully sad.

084 gleeful *adjective*

EMOTION & FEELING

exuberantly happy

Children were **gleeful** at the surprise party, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

MEMORY CUE: A gleeful child bounces beneath a burst of exuberant happiness.

085 disconsolate *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

without consolation or comfort; unhappy

The **disconsolate** widow mourned for months, shaping the mood of the group as the events continued to unfold.

MEMORY CUE: A disconsolate person sits beneath rain with no comfort able to reach them.

086 blissful *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

extremely happy; full of joy

They spent a **blissful** week at the beach, revealing how strongly the experience affected the people involved in the situation.

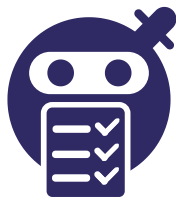
MEMORY CUE: A blissful face glows in a warm circle of complete joy.

087 wretched *adjective***EMOTION & FEELING**

in a very unhappy or unfortunate state

The **wretched** conditions appalled inspectors, making the emotional response visible to everyone who witnessed the interaction.

MEMORY CUE: A wretched figure crouches in a deeply unhappy and unfortunate state.
